DOS & DON'TS OF CSPE SOLICITATION

<u>DO</u>

DO ask your dues-paying members and retired DON'T solicit agency-fee payers, family members or members to contribute. other non-union members to contribute. DO tell members that contributing is voluntary. DON'T coerce a member to contribute. DO ask members to fill out AFTPA's online form. DON'T fill-in the online form for someone else. DO suggest a contribution amount AND notify the DON'T require a fixed amount for contributions. member of the option to determine their level of contribution. DO email the link to the online form to dues-paying DON'T email the link to the online form to non-dues members. paying members. DO send solicitations to and from non-work email DON'T send solicitations to or from employer-providaddresses. ed work email addresses. DO use a personal device, such as a laptop or iPad, to DON'T use any device or network owned or operated contribute. by your employer to contribute.

Discuss

• Issues not parties – Most members can agree on issues, such as Vouchers, Tenure, Budget Cuts, and Evaluations.

• The purpose of CSPE – Non-partisan. To support State and Local candidates who support us. This fund does not support candidates for federal office.

• CSPE Contributions are not tax deductible.

Avoid

- Non-Education or Non-Labor Issues Avoid divisive topics and socially sensitive issues.
- Party Affiliation Discussing political parties can cause conflict.
